Gas Tax Money can be used for purchasing Road Equipment. (#5735.27 & #5549.21) Ohio Revised Code.
- 2. Mr. Martin Vince, Head Supervisor of the State Auditing Staff for Townships stated that Gas Tax Moneys can be used for Road Construction, maintenance, repair and purchase of machinery and equipment.
- 3. Mr. Allison: Right of way- Set Back of Shrubs Stated that trustees have the right to control any planting in the road right of way.

Mr. Koerner, County Engineer's office stated that Rosslyn Avenue has a 50 foot right-away and that it is a 26 foot street, therefore, Trustees can control 12 foot from back of curb. Ray Hickey, Franklin County Zoning Department, stated that the County Commissioners resolved that shrubs must not be more than 3 foot max.height to building set back and not shruberry to 25ft. set back on corner lots and further resolved that no hedge or fence in rêsidential areas can be more than 75% solid or over 3ft. in height.

Mr. Hickey recommends that the property owners on Rosslyn whos shrub block the view from driveways be contacted and advised on the above rulings. If they do not correct the situation trustees can then notify the County Zoning Board of the violation and they will force the property owners to conform.
