

A letter was received from the Franklin County Budget Commission regarding the Local Government Fund Distribution. Sharon Township will receive \$2,500.00. In view of this letter Chairman of the Board of Trustees introduced the following resolution.

#### RESOLUTION

Whereas Sharon Township Trustees have found they cannot hire sufficient day time volunteer firemen to adequately protect the property and life of the township taxpayers, and

Whereas this situation developed after the 1959 Budget was submitted to the Budget Commission, and

Whereas as the only solution appears to hire (2) two full time day firemen at an estimated cost of \$10,000.00, and

Whereas the situation was pointed out at the Budget Commission hearing on the distribution of the Local Government Fund with an accompanying request for the #10,000.00 needed, and

Whereos the secretary of the Budget Commission has notified us that \$2,500.00 (the same amount received 1958- and needed to meet the 1959 Budget submitted in May of 1958) is the amount of the Local Covernment money allocated to Sharon Township for 1959, and

Whereas the City of Columbus which ended the 1958 year with a \$2,000,000.00 surplus is to receive \$1,500,000.00 from the Local Government Fund (An increase of \$95,000.00 over the 1958 allocation.)

Whereas byllaw Local Government Fund money is to be distributed according to need and,

Whereas, the need of Sharon Township was ignored and the questionable need of Columbus was rewarded by the Budget Commission,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Sharon Township Clerk be instructed to make an appointment for the Sharon Township Trustees with the County Prosecutor to discuss litigation to be taken to appeal the decision of the Pudget Commission.
