The following were present: Trustees, John D. Loomis, Earl B. Smith, Melvin L. Thomas; Clerk, Eleanor Bierly.

The first meeting of the year 1961 was called to order by the township clerk.

The December 29th 1960 minutes were read and approved.

Clerk asked for nominations from the floor for the Chairman and Vice=Chairman.

Mr. Loomis nominated Mr. Thomas as Chairman seconded by Mr. Smith, all voted "aye" thereon. Mr. Smith nominated Mr. Loomis as Vice-Chairman, seconded by Mr. Thomas. All voted "aye" thereon.

Trustees set the second Wednesday and fourth Thursday of each month at Sharon Township Hall, time 7:30 P.M. as the regular meeting nights.

Clerk submitted the Financial Fund report for 1960.

War Memorial Statement was received from secretary, John T. Gray.

The Ohio State Convention of Township Trustees and clerks will be held January 18, 19, 20, 21, 1961. Mr. Loomis moved, second by Mr. Smith that all expenses to and from and during the convention for those attending be paid. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that Merlin E. Denig be redesignated as Sharon Township Road Superintendent and Flint Cemetery Superintendent, and that his compensation be set at \$60.00 per week for his duties (\$30.00 Gas Tax - \$30.00 Flint Cemetery) as Superintendent. Mr. Denig's bond to be set at \$1,000.00; that he be authorized to employ such help as he may deem necessary and that the same be compensated at a rate set by him not to exceed \$2.10 per hour. All voted "aye" thereon.

Flint Cemetery price of lots, grave spaces and opening and closing a grave tabled until the February 8th meeting.

Mr. Smith moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Harold A. Morgan be re-employed for 1961, as the Sharon Township Fire Station Custodian, that the custodian be compensated \$225.00 per month; payable 1st and 15th of each month; that he have two weeks vacation with pay; that the custodian obtain a reliable person to take charge during this two week vacation period for \$100.00; that he employ the custodian relief one day per week not to exceed \$10.00 per week. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Smith moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that Jerry Cunningham be re-employed as Fire House Custodian under the direction of Fire Chief L. C. Brown as set forth in the April 5th, 1959 minutes, rules and regulations; and be compensated \$385.00 per month for his duties. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that L. F. Sanford be re-employed as Fire House Custodian under the direction of Fire Chief L. C. Brown as set forth in the April 5, 1959 minutes, rules and regulations, and be compensated \$400.00 per month for his duties. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Smith moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that L. F. Sanford and Jerry Cunningham be allowed a two week vacation time for 1961. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that the officers be paid as set forth; that the fire and emergency run compensation for the fiscal year 1961 be set as follows:

1.50 for the 2nd hour or fraction thereof,
2.50 for the 3rd hour and any other or fraction thereof.
All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Smith moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that the compensation of the township clerk to be set at \$500.00 base, plus 2% of all expenditures in the excess of \$5,000.00 not to exceed \$2,400.00 for the fiscal year 1961 as set forth by law. The \$1,000.00 renewal bond be paid at \$10.00. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis and Mr. Smith requested the Chairman to continue scheduling the use of the township hall when requested and when it is necessary.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that the township advertise for a two ton dump truck - opening to be January 28, 1961 at noon. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that an appropriation of \$10,000.00 for the General Fund and \$3,000.00 for the Gas Tax Fund be appropriated for the interim.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that the following be tabled until next meeting January 11, 1960. Compensations for Constable Barker, Norman C. Severance, L. C. Brown, Fire Chief, Clerk is to obtain a list of all firemen from Fire Chief for the January 11th minutes.

Attached to these minutes is the Form DS-4 - Township Debt - for 1961.

Mr. Denig appeared before the board, trustees discussed cemetery and road work. Trustees and Road Supt. pleased with the article in the Worthington News about the clearance of township road from ice and snow during the recent snow storms.



Melvin L. Thomas, 771 Morning Street, was elected chairman of the Sharon Township Trustees at their organizational meeting January 2. He succeeds Earl B. Smith, 131 West Stafford Avenue. John D. Loomis, 1020 Kilbourne Dr., was elected vice chairman. L. C. Brown, 551 Oxford, was re-appointed fire chief.

Merlin Denig was designated as Flint Cemetery and road superintendent while O. J. Barker and Norman C. Severance were appointed police constables.

The Sharon Township Trustees' meeting dates have been changed to the second Wednesday and fourth Thursday of each month. The time of the meetings is 7:30 p.m.

The trustees are presently accepting bids on a 1961 truck chassis to be used for road work. The bids will be opened by the clerk at the Sharon Township Hall at noon Saturday, January 21st.

The December 21 and 29th minutes were re-read. The January 2nd minutes were read and approved.

Trustees and Flint Cemetery Supt. discussed cemetery lot prices, opening and closing of graves. Supt. is to check with Walnut Grove Cemetery prices and report to Trustees at the February 8, 1961 meeting.

Trustees discussed the matter with Fire Chief and have asked that he make this decision regarding vacation time as it seemed as good as anytime to allow vacations to be scheduled but authorization comes under the Fire Chief jurisdiction.
