Fire Levy Wins By Big Majority

In what is believed to be the biggest approval ever given a tax levy in this community, Worthington, Riverlea and Sharon Township voters Tuesday renewed a one-mill township fire protection levy by an overwhelming majority of 82 per cent of the votes cast.

An incomplete unofficial tabunation of the votes made by "The News" showed a total of 3829 votes being cast in favor of the levy and only 850 votes being cast against the renewal.
