The following were present: Trustees, John D. Loomis, Earl B. Smith, Melvin L. Thomas; Clerk, Eleanor Bierly; Constables Urban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance.

The first meeting of the year 1962 was called to order by the township clerk. Oath of office for Trustees Melvin L. Thomas and Earl B. Smith was officiated by township clerk.

The December 28th, 1961 minutes were read and approved.

Clerk asked for nominations from the floor for the Chairman and Vice-Chairman, after the oath of office was given to Earl B. Smith, Trustee and Melvin L. Thomas, Trustee. Eleanor Bierly, Clerk officiated oaths to trustees.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that John D. Loomis serve as Chairman of the Board. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that Earl B. Smith be Vice-Chairman of the Board. All voted "aye" thereon.

Trustees set the second Wednesday and fourth Thursday of each month at Sharon Township Hall, time 7:30 P.M. as the regular meeting nights. The next meetings will be January 3, 10, and 25th this month.

The Ohio State Convention of Township Trustees and Clerks will be held January 17, 18, 19 & 20th, 1962. Mr. Smith moved seconded by Mr. Thomas that all expenses to and from and during the convention plus garage expenses be paid. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Smith that an appropriation of \$10,000.00 for the General Fund and \$3,000.00 for the Gas Tax fund be appropriated for the interim, until total amounts are received from the County Auditor.

Mr. Thomas introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Sharon Township, Franklin County, Worthington, Ohio:

That, Urban J. Barker and Norman C. Severance be re-employed and designated as Police Constables for Sharon Township.

That the compensation of Constable Urban J. Barker be set at \$300.00 per month payable on the 1st and 15th of each month for the performance of his duties as Sharon Township Police Constable keeping the peace and protecting the property and performing the duties as a police constable, to have a two weeks, vacation with pay, and have a \$1,000.00 Police Constable Bond.

The following were present: Trustees, John D. Loomis, Melvin L. Thomas; Clerk, Eleanor Bierly; Fire Chief, L. F. Sanford Mr. H. R. Shaffer, 3 West Southington, Worthington, Ohio

January 3, 1962 minutes were reread and January 10th minutes were read and approved.

Clerk submitted, Financial Statement, reported that Form A-36-3 Certificate of Total Amount from all sources available for expenditures and balances had been returned to the County Auditor. Reported that Form A-37-3 had been received from the Budget Commission, Official Certificate of Estimated Resources. Total amount estimated at \$135,826.99 - based on \$36,000,000.00 duplicate.

Chairman asked Trustees Thomas to schedule the use of the township hall.

Trustees discussed the Annual Township Mileage report that Trustees Thomas and Smith submitted at the January 10th meeting. The Township has 10.07 miles of roads as of December 14, 1961.

Mr. Shaffer appeared before the board to discuss a dispute regarding the zoning of his property at the corner of Southington and High Street. Requested search for the petition for Incorporation for the Village of Riverlea in 1939-1940. He had a photo-copy of the typed signatures and called the trustees attention to the fact that some lived in rental property and were not freeholders as required. Village of Riverlea had approved his building plans for office space on High street with two apartments on Southington and now object to the office space tht is being used.

Fire Chief reported on all fire department matters, submitted the Firemens Roster, reported on the ladder truck, trustees requested that he submit a uniform list for dress uniforms sizes etc, how many needed and for whom, check with various companies for prices etc. Requested the need for four new rain coats. Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that four light weight rain coats be purchased not to exceed the amount of \$100.00.

Trustees discussed the Sharon Township Memorial Board of Trustees 1961 Financial Statement, 1962 Budget and their request from \$2,500.00 for 1962 again. Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Loomis that \$2,500.00 be appropriated from the general fund for the Sharon Township Memorial Board. All voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. Loomis moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas that the February meetings be held February 7th and February 22, 1962.







In what is believed to be the biggest approval ever given a tax levy in this community, Worthington, Riverlea and Sharon Township voters Tuesday renewed a one-mill township fire protection levy by an overwhelming majority of 82 per cent of the votes cast.


