Follow-up on Hate Speech Issue

Kunze went today to discuss access to the park with neighborhood leaders. Kunze discussed some of the issues that have been brought forward by the residents. The bridge has proven to be the focus of discussion regarding access. (This issue was brought to the Trustees at the last meeting.) Kunze is working to facilitate several discussions to assist with access to avoid Flint Road and maintain access to the park. Supt. Kayati provided a situational awareness of the layout of the property.

New Business:

Memorial Board

Gary Beougher, President of the Board provided an update on the construction and presented a series of questions for the Trustees. Work on the Sharon Memorial will begin soon. Beougher mentioned that Palmer had put the Sharon Memorial Board in touch with the Ohio Connection for a possible \$10,000 grant. The Board applied for the grant and await word on award. The VFW is installing a patio at the Sharon Memorial Hall to honor veterans. Work will begin once the bricks are engraved—likely next month.

Beougher went through the four questions he presented:

- 1) Beougher discussed the former 501(c)(3) and informed Trustees that the status has lapsed. Beougher asked about the need for an EIN or "tax-exempt number." Oberle explained that the Sharon Memorial Board is a creature of statute. Oberle stated that the County Prosecutor should opine on these legal questions. Oberle also explained the nature of the limited authority of the Township.
- 2) Beougher discussed the designation as a "War Memorial." Beougher reported that the Memorial Board had previously discussed the matter with the County Prosecutor. Oberle discussed that they should discuss the matter and potentially could help facilitate an introduction to County Prosecutor staff—which will lead to answers for many of the questions Beougher has stated. Oberle noted that the Township does not own the Sharon Memorial. The question about ownership of the Sharon Memorial was raised. Discussion occurred about historical aspects of the relationship. Beougher discussed the current operating environment.

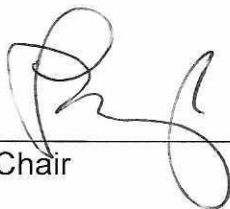

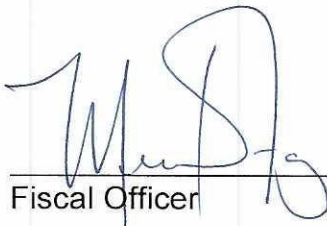
