Absentee Voting by Mail

It's Safe, Secure, and Simple

- Absentee Voting is a three step process:
 - 1 Request an application, or download and print your own
 - 2 Turn in application
 - **3** Receive ballot, mark selections and fill out ID envelope and return ballot by deadline
- Commonly missed items on forms:
 - Signature
 - Date of Birth
 - Last Four Digits of Your Social Security Number
 - Driver's License Number
- Track your Absentee Ballot from time of Request to Ballot Acceptance using BallotTrax:

- Deadline for returning an absentee ballot:
 - Postmark by <u>Tuesday November 1, 2021</u> and received within <u>10 days of</u> <u>Tuesday November 2, 2021</u>
