Old Business

Potential Annexation on Hanawalt Road - Update

The City of Westerville will not provide water without annexation of the property. The property owners are looking to find sewer service for the property. The Township is expecting a response from the City of Westerville on sewer services within the next week.

Complaint Regarding Property on Old Woods Road - Update

Franklin County Zoning is reviewing whether the gardening structures in the front yard of the property at issue violate the Franklin County Zoning Resolution.

Worthington/Township Fire District – Update

John Oberle and Tony Palmer met with officials from the City Worthington about the City’s request for the Township to increase the fire levy. The

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Township continues to review how the fire and emergency services are funded and compare the costs by Worthington and Township residents. The City has indicated that it will be asking the Township to put a fire levy on the ballot in November.

The Township received a voluntary property survey from the Franklin County Auditor regarding the Township Hall property. Laura Kunze indicated she would review the survey.

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New Business


Request to Extend an Offer of Employment to Bryan Gearheart
