**Juneteenth Holiday\***

Oberle explained that the Cemetery Board added Juneteenth as a holiday. Oberle explained that many other jurisdictions have recognized the holiday. Kunze also noted that it was important to recognize the holiday. Oberle questioned how it would be treated for employee leave purposes. Discussion occurred that employees would have it treated like other holidays. The Trustees will vote on a resolution at the next meeting. Chief Tuchfarber sought clarification as to how the day would be treated for employees so that he can adjust budget projections accordingly.

**Resolution to Designate a Historic Landmark\***

Oberle mentioned that this topic was discussed at the last meeting. This designation of the Ozem Gardner property is important because of the involvement in the assistance of moving escaped slaves north during the 1800's. It will also assist in building code compliance. Palmer provided the historic significance of the building including that it was a stop on the Underground Railroad.

A resident asked if this designation would help gain funds. Oberle noted that it would not necessarily bring in funds, but could allow the Township to save money. Oberle noted that it could potentially assist in securing new phones.

Palmer moved, Kunze seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**Approval of Spring Landscaping Clean-Up/Mulch at Township Offices\***

Palmer explained that the cost for the project would be \$1284.99 from Linnabary Landscaping. Kunze approved, Oberle seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
